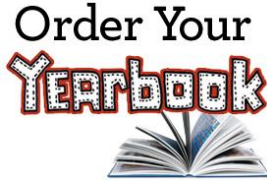

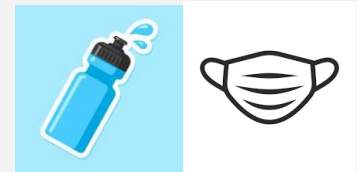


Transportation and Late Bus Information
